In this fun and engaging six-week Acrylic Marker Illustration course, we'll find inspiration in the beauty of everyday subjects—from colourful still life and flowers to water, trees, and landscapes—while exploring the unique and versatile qualities of acrylic paint markers.

Each week, you'll complete a different beautifully finished artwork. Through step-by-step demonstrations and guidance, you'll learn practical techniques including colour layering, line work, texture, light and shadow, highlights, reflections, and depth. Starting with approachable techniques and gradually building your skills, you'll discover just how enjoyable and rewarding creating art can be.

No previous drawing or painting experience is required. I'll bring a selection of acrylic markers from my studio for participants to try during the first class. If you're unsure which markers to purchase, feel free to wait—you can try them first and bring your own set starting from the second class.

Bring a little curiosity, enjoy six weeks of creative time, and take home a collection of beautiful artworks created by you.
